2010 Camp Pendleton Mid-Range Prone 1050 Point Aggregate High Power Rifle Tournament Program and Entry Form

The Santa Margarita Gun Club of Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, California is sponsoring the 2010 Camp Pendleton Mid-Range Prone 1050 Point Aggregate High Power Rifle Tournament. The Tournament will consist of a 60 Shot 600 Point (3x600) Mid-Range Aggregate and a 45 Shot 450 Point (3,5,600 Yd) Mid-Range Aggregate.

Tournament Dates: August 28, 2010 - 600 Point Mid-Range (MR) Prone (3x600 Yd) Aggregate

August 29, 2010 - 450 Point Mid-Range (MR) Prone (3,5,600 Yd) Aggregate

Tournament Sponsor & Address: Santa Margarita Gun Club, Inc; P.O. Box 4858, Oceanside, CA 92052-4858.

Range Location: Range 103, Wilcox Range Complex, Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, CA. Refer to Directions to Ranges 102/103, attached, for vehicle entry requirements to Camp Pendleton and detailed driving directions to the range.

<u>Range Facilities</u>: Range 103 is a 140 point firing range. Sanitary facilities are of the "Port-a-Potty" variety. There are no food or drink facilities, it is highly recommended that you bring bottled drinks (non-alcoholic) and/or non-perishable food items. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on or in the general vicinity of the firing lines.

Rules: The Camp Pendleton Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the National Rifle Association (NRA) High Power Rifle Rules which are in effect on the tournament commencement date.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Competitors must be U.S. citizens or citizens of a foreign country legally admitted to the United States. Those persons who cannot legally participate in shooting sports or who cannot enter a federal military reservation are not eligible to participate in this tournament.

Camp Pendleton security regulations require that SMGC notify the Military Police of non-DoD ID personnel participating in shooting activities no later than 3 working days prior to the activity. This notification is made by SMGC and based upon received competitor registrations. Entry onto Camp Pendleton may be delayed for those persons who do not comply with the advance entry notification requirement.

Membership in the NRA is not required to compete. Those competitors who are not members of the NRA or NRA members who can not produce a valid personal rifle classification card will be required to compete in the Master Class.

Entries: Entries will be limited to 60 competitors for this tournament

Entries Close: All entries must be received not later than close of normal business hours on August 24, 2010. "Walk-In" entries may be accepted up to closing time of the Statistical Office on the day of the Match.

Competitors who are not members of the SMGC are required to pay a Daily Membership Fee.

<u>Check-In Procedures</u>: Upon arrival, all competitors must report to the Match Statistical Office for administrative processing. The Statistical Office will be open from 6:30 AM to 7:15 AM on the morning of the match.

All competitors are required to complete the check-in processing and make payment of tournament fees before they can participate.

Squadding: Upon completion of administrative processing, competitors will receive their relay & firing point assignment. All competitors must report to the 600 or 200, as appropriate, yard line not later than 7:30 AM to attend a mandated range safety and environmental briefing

Target Pullers: Target Pullers will be provided.

<u>Classifications</u>: The NRA High Power Rifle Classification System will be used for this tournament. An Assigned Classification (Rule 19.6), or a Temporary Classification (Rule 19.4) may be used, if applicable. Unclassified and competitors who are not members of the National Rifle Association will compete in the Master Class (Rule 19.2). F-Class competitors will be classed separately.

Spotting Scopes: Competitors may use scopes for scoring purposes.

<u>Safety Equipment</u>: Hearing Protection, Eye Protection, and Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) or Empty Chamber Flags are mandatory.

<u>Other Equipment</u>: Cloth, canvas or leather shooting jackets may be used. Standard military-issue web or leather slings or slings of this same type are permitted. Shooting gloves or mitts, ground cloths or shooting mats may be used. Shooting kits may be placed on the firing line provided they are not forward of the competitor or the firing line and do not interfere with other competitors.

Rifle Types Allowed: Service, Match (to include Palma, Any/Any, Any/Iron), or F-Class.

<u>Sights</u>: Metallic – Rule 3.7(a); Telescopic – Rule 3.7(b). Service Rifles using sights other than metallic will be classed as NRA Match Rifles.

<u>Ammunition</u>: Competitors must supply their own ammunition. Any safe center-fire ammunition, up to and including 7.62mm (.308 caliber), may be used. **Tracer**, **incendiary**, **or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited** – Rule 3.17(b).

Match Start Time: 07:45 AM Daily.

Targets: Official NRA Targets will be used.

<u>Sighting Shots</u>: Sighting shots are allowed and may be taken at the shooter's option. "Sighting Shots" must be declared and recorded before "record shots" are fired.

<u>Challenges</u>: A fee of \$2.00 is required and payable upon requesting the challenge. If the challenge is denied, the fee will be forfeit

Categories and Classes for Aggregate and Individual Match Awards

Separate rifle categories will be established for Service or Match Rifles; if there less than 5 entries in a category, then both rifle categories will be combined into one. F-Class will be listed separately.

Competitors may be further grouped by sub-categories; i.e., service, civilian, police, etc, as defined by NRA rules, at the discretion of Match Officials. If there are less than 5 competitors in a specific category, then that category will be combined with another category until there are at least 5 competitors in the combined category.

<u>Aggregate and Individual Match Winner</u> Awards will be given. Aggregate and/or Individual Match Winners will be given that award only regardless of their individual classification.

Awards

High Master Class: There must be 3 to 6 entries in this class for one award, 7 to 10 for two awards, and 11 or more for three awards. If there are 2 or less High Masters entered, they will fire for open awards only. The High Master Classification will not be combined with the Master Class.

All other classes: There must be 5 to 10 entries in a class for one award, 11 to 15 for two awards, and 16 or more for three awards

If there are fewer than five (5) shooters in a specific class, then these competitors will be combined with those of the next higher class. Should there be less than 5 Masters entered then this rule will not apply and they will have their own class.

Special Awards Categories: A High Shooter Award may be given, at the discretion of the Match Director for the Grand Senior, Senior, Junior and Women Categories; provided there are 5 or more competitors in the category and is in addition to any other awards earned.

RELEASE FROM RESPONSIBILITY, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK FOR PARTICIPATION IN A DANGEROUS ACTIVITY

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of permitting THE UNDERSIGNED to enter the MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP PENDLETON AND SANTA MARGARITA GUN CLUB, herein referred to as the "Santa Margarita Gun Club", premises for the purposes of firearms use, shooting of firearms, observing the shooting of firearms, or any and all other purposes, THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself/herself his/hers heirs, executors, administrators and assigns:

- 1. Hereby voluntarily releases, discharges, waivers and relinquishes any and all actions or causes of action for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to the undersigned arising as a result of engaging in or being present at activities at the San Margarita Gun Club premises.
- 2. Hereby covenants not to sue and voluntarily releases, waivers, discharges and relinquishes any action or causes of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for himself/herself and for his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns prosecute or present any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against MCB, Camp Pendleton, CA, or the Santa Margarita Gun Club or any of its officers, agents, servants or employees for any of said causes of action, whether the same shall arise by negligence of any of said persons or otherwise. IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE UNDERSIGNED BY THIS INSTRUMENT, TO EXEMPT AND RELIEVE THE SANTA MARGARITA GUN CLUB OR ANY OF ITS' OFFICERS, AGENTS, SERVANTS OR EMPLOYEES; INCLUDING VOLUNTEERS, FROM LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE.
- 3. Agrees that in the event any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death shall be prosecuted against the Santa Margarita Gun Club. The Undersigned shall indemnify and save harmless the same Santa Margarita Gun Club and any of its officers, agents, servants or employees, including volunteers, from any and claims or causes of action by whomever or wherever made or presented for personal injuries, property damage or wrongful death.
- 4. Agrees that the foregoing release is intended to be as broad and inclusive a permitted by the laws applicable in the State of California and that of any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
- 5. Acknowledges that the Undersigned has been fully and completely advised of the potential for serious accident incidental to engaging in firearms activities, including the potential for death, personal injury and property damage, and expressly agrees to assume all risks of loss, damage or injury that may be sustained by the Undersigned.

The Undersigned has read the foregoing paragraphs and voluntarily signs this agreement being fully aware of legal consequences of signing the within instrument.

6. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements and shall remain in force until January 31, 2011,

Personnel & Motor Vehicle Entry Requirements to Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, California and Driving Directions to Ranges 102, 103, 116, & 117

Range Location: Camp Pendleton is located 35 miles north of San Diego, CA, adjacent to Oceanside, and south of San Clemente, CA. Within Camp Pendleton, Ranges 102 & 103 are located northwest of the Marine Corps Air Station (23 Area) and southwest of Camp Margarita (33 Area). Ranges 116 & 117 are located immediately adjacent to Basilone Road, approximately 6 miles from the junction of Basilone Road & Vandegrift Blvd.

Entry Into Camp Pendleton: Entry onto Camp Pendleton can be made from either the Main Gate or San Onofre Gate. Be prepared to provide the following documents: a valid driver's license with your photo affixed, current vehicle registration and automobile liability insurance that meets the California minimums, and firearms information. You may be asked to show your firearm(s) to security personnel at the gate ensuring that it is not loaded, detachable magazines are removed from the weapon, and there is no ammunition in the magazine(s). Both firearms and ammunition must be transported in separately locked cases (please comply with all California firearms laws) prior to proceeding to the range. Persons who cannot participate in the shooting sports due to judicial convictions, or "barred", (either voluntarily and/or involuntarily) from entry onto a DOD installation are not eligible to participate in a SMGC endeavor.

<u>Driving Aboard Camp Pendleton</u>: Please obey all posted speed limits. Troops marching on or along side of any road have the right of way, slow down to 15 MPH until past the formation. Obey any directions given by the Military Police. Failure to obey posted speed limits or traffic regulations may result in citations answerable in Federal Commissioner's Court.

Interstate I-5 North: From Interstate I-5 north, take Oceanside/Camp Pendleton exit. Go to the Main Gate. At the Main gate, you may be asked to produce the documents described above. After going through the Main Gate, you will be on Vandegrift Boulevard. Stay on Vandegrift Boulevard for approximately 8 1/2 miles to Basilone Road. Just past the Marine Corps Air Station, make a left turn onto Basilone Road. Cross over the bridge and for

Ranges 102 and 103 - Take the first left onto Stagecoach Road toward Camp Margarita (33 Area). At about 1 mile, the road splits, go left and stay on that road (Rifle Range Road) until you come to a stop sign. Continue straight ahead. The rifle range (Range 103) is about 500 yards past the stop sign on the right. If your destination is the pistol range (Range 102), continue on this road for one (1) mile. Stay on the hard top and you will arrive at the pistol range.

Ranges 116 and 117 - Continue on Basilone Road for approximately 5 miles after the bridge, you will see a sign for Range 117, and a 2 story control tower on the left side of the road and a driveway. Turn left into the driveway and continue into the parking area. If your destination is Range 116, do not turn but continue straight ahead for 1 mile. Range 116 will be on the left. Turn left in driveway and proceed to parking lot.

Interstate I-5 South: From Interstate I-5 south, exit at San Onofre/Basilone Road. At the stop sign, turn left and continue straight to the San Onofre Gate. At the San Onofre Gate, you may be asked to produce the documents described above. After going through the San Onofre Gate you will be on Basilone Road.

Range 116 and 117 - Continue on Basilone Road for approximately 15 miles. Range 116 is on the right side, turn right into the driveway and proceed to the parking lot. If you designation is Range 117, continue on Basione Rd for one more mile. You will see a 2 story control tower on the right side of the road and a driveway. Turn right into the driveway and continue into the parking area

Range 102 and 103 - Continue on Basilone Road for approximately 20 miles. Turn right onto onto Stagecoach Road toward Camp Margarita (33 Area). At about 1 mile, the road splits, go left and stay on that road (Rifle Range Road) until you come to a stop sign. Continue straight ahead. The rifle range (Range 103) is about 500 yards past the stop sign on the right. If your destination is the pistol range (Range 102), continue on this road for one (1) mile. Stay on the hard top and you will arrive at the pistol range.
