EIC Match Program
Service Pistol & CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol

The CMP Service Pistol EIC Match and .22 Rimfire EIC Match is sponsored by: Santa Margarita Gun Club

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants. You need not be a member of the NRA or a CMP affiliated club to participate. You must be a US citizen or Green Card holder to access Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton.

The deadline for registration for non-SMGC members is Thursday August 8 at 9pm due to base access procedures. Detailed instructions will be sent out in an email thru Practiscore.com approximately August 10. You will be required to go to the Visitors Center on base Thursday or Friday preceding the match to obtain your base access pass.

Military and SMGC members can register thru 9pm Friday August 16.

Registration: All registration will be thru Practiscore. You will need to setup an account (which is free) to register and make payments.

Time, Date: 7:30am, August 18, 2019 at Range 214 and R213 Camp Pendleton, CA.

Muster and check in will go at the Range 214 parking lot. We want all shooters to be in the parking area and checked in at 7:30am so that we can conduct our Range Safety Brief and squad the match.

Match Fees (per Match): Military \$20, SMGC Annual Member \$35, Daily SMGC Member \$50. Fees will be collected thru Practiscore at the time of registration.

For instance: If you are military and shooting a single match you will be charged \$20. If you are military shooting both matches, you will be charged \$40.

Course of Fire: COF for Service Pistol EIC and .22 Rimfire EIC Pistol is the 30 shot National Match Course of Fire (Table 5).

First	50 yds. ¹	Slow	Standing	1 series of 10 shots	10 min. per series	After 10 shots
Second	25 yds.	Timed	Standing ²	2 series of 5 shots	20 sec. per series	After 10 shots
Third	25 yds.	Rapid	Standing ²	2 series of 5 shots	10 sec. per series	After 10 shots

The match will be conducted in the following manner:

R214 - 50 Yard Slow Fire Only:

Match 1A – Service Pistol at 50 yards slow fire

Match 1B – .22 Rimfire at 50 yards slow fire

Move to R213, conduct the timed and rapid fire matches at R213

Match 2A - Service Pistol 25 yard timed fire

Match 2B - Service Pistol 25 yard rapid fire

Match 3A - .22 Rimfire 25 yard timed fire

Match 3B - .22 Rimfire 25 yard rapid fire

Competitors can fire either Service Pistol EIC or 22Rimfire EIC or both matches.

Firearm: “Service Pistol,” “.22 Rimfire Pistol” as defined in the Current Edition of the CMP Competitions (See below for rule book). It is not the responsibility of the Santa Margarita Gun Club to ensure your firearm is in compliance with the rulebook prior to arrival at the match site.

Entries: 60 shooters maximum, there must be at least six non-distinguished shooters. Non-Distinguished shooters will get priority.

Awards: Gold, Silver & Bronze Place Medals will be presented to the top three competitors (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished). Gold, Silver & Bronze Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors, by the sponsoring club, after the event (Distinguished or Non-Distinguished), in CMP Sanctioned EIC Matches, that equal or exceed Achievement Award Scores. **Points** – Points are given to

any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non-distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score. All Points are issued by the CMP. **Minimum EIC Scores** – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline. MCS scores for are:

- Service Pistol. 250 x 300
- .22 Rimfire Pistol. 260 x 300

Rules: In accordance with the current edition of the CMP Highpower Rifle & Pistol Competition Rulebook. All Service Pistol EIC Matches, CMP .22 Rimfire EIC Pistol Matches or Service Rifle EIC Matches will be governed by CMP Rules.
